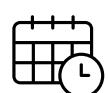

Climax

- Visit Jaisalmer Fort, the largest desert living fort in the world, and hear the residents who live there tell folktales.
- Enjoy the pink city while watching the sunset from the edge of the Nahargarh Fort's walls.
- Visit Mehrangarh Fort in Jodhpur, one of India's largest and best-preserved forts, and take photos of the dazzling blue city from the top.
- Take comfort from the remarkable Tanot Mata Temple near Sam Sand Dunes, where it is said that the presence of heavenly forces here helped to defuse over 3000 bombs and save the lives of many soldiers.
- When you visit Saheliyon Ki Bari, unwind on the marble bench where the former Maharaja and Maharani formerly reclined while admiring the royal and peaceful view.



Things not to miss

- Learn the techniques used to create the renowned Jaipur Blue Pottery, which is made without clay.
- Admire the enormous Jaivana Cannon from the 18th century in Jaigarh, whose projectile created a small lake in Chaksu after travelling over 35 kilometres.
- Visit the Vintage Car Museum in Udaipur, which features some of the most gorgeous collections of Antique Cars, to get a glimpse into the royal way of life.
- Try Janta Sweets' renowned Jodhpuri Mirchi Vada to tantalise your palate.
- Visit Om Banna Temple to pay respect to the 350cc Royal Enfield Bullet Motorcycle and learn about its enigmatic emergence.
- Visit the village of Kuldhara to find out why the entire community was abandoned over night due to a curse.

How to reach

By Air: Jaipur's Sanganer Airport is situated right in the middle of the city. There are flights between the airport and important Indian cities including Mumbai and Delhi. From the airports in Mumbai or Delhi, international travelers can take connecting flights to Jaipur.

By Rail: The primary entrance to the city is Jaipur Junction Railway Station. Jaipur is connected to prominent cities including Delhi, Mumbai, Udaipur, and Jodhpur by direct trains.

By Road: The major cities of Delhi, Agra, Kota, Mumbai, Ahmedabad, Udaipur, Vadodara, and Ajmer are all easily accessible by road from Jaipur.



Day Wise Itinerary

Day 01: - Arrival in Pink City of India (Jaipur)

After your Arrival in Jaipur Our representative will pick you from Jaipur Railway Station/Airport. After that check in to the pre booked hotel have some rest and then you can visit: - Jal Mahal, Hawa Mahal, Albert Hall, Birla mandir, etc. After that come back to the hotel and overnight stay.

Day 02: - Jaipur Full Day Sightseeing

Wake up in the morning have breakfast and then go for the full day sightseeing of Jaipur like: - Nahargarh fort, Amer Fort, City Palace, Jantar Mantar, etc. After that you can visit Chokhi Dhani (must visit place in Jaipur famous for its Pure Rajasthani food & culture). After that come back to the hotel and overnight stay.

Day 03: - Jaipur to Bikaner

Wake up in the morning have your delicious breakfast and then check out from the hotel. After that move towards to the Bikaner. After reaching there check in to the pre booked hotel have some rest and then go for the sightseeing of Bikaner like :- Junagarh Fort , Shri Laxminath Temple , Prachina Museum , The Laxmi Niwas Palace , Rampuria Haveli etc. After that in evening come back to the hotel for overnight stay.



Day 06: - Bikaner to Jaisalmer City (Golden City)

Wake up in the morning have breakfast and then checkout from the hotel and then move towards to Jaisalmer City. After reaching there check in to the pre booked hotel have some rest and then in evening go for the sightseeing of Jaisalmer like :- Gadisagar Lake (enjoy boating in just 100 per person approx.) After that you can go for the sightseeing of local area market as well. Here you can buy some good quality products of wooden & leather. And then you can enjoy the puppet shows as well through out the sightseeing of local area market as well. After that come back to the hotel for overnight stay.

Day 05: - Jaisalmer Sightseeing & SAM Activities

Wake up in the morning have breakfast and then checkout from the hotel and then go for the sightseeing of Jaisalmer like: - Gadisagar Lake (enjoy boating in just 100 per person approx.), Jaisalmer Fort, Patwo ki Haveli, Moti Mahal (Salam Singh haveli), Vyas Chhatri, Nathmal ki Haveli, etc. After that head towards Jaisalmer SAM. On the way you can enjoy sightseeing of Kuldhara Village (Rajasthan's Eerie Village). After reaching SAM check in to the Camp, you will be welcomed by Rajasthani style Tilak & Aarti. After that have some rest in Camp and then at the time of Sunset you can go to Enjoy Camel Safari on sand dunes (the most beautiful time to click pictures on camel safari) of approx. 30min. After that come back to the camp and enjoy Rajasthani folk Dance program like: - Matka Dance, Kalbeliya Dance, Ghoomar, etc. After that DJ Night, Group dance and Bonfire During this program you will be served Evening tea & snacks. After that have your Rajasthani Style Dinner in camp and then overnight stay.



Day 06: - Jeep Safari On Dunes to Jodhpur (Blue City)

Wake up in the morning and then go for the Jeep Safari on sand dunes (best time to do is Sunrise timing) you will be covered mainly 3 deserts of Rajasthan: - The Thar Desert, Royal Desert, Mughal Desert of Approx. 45 min. After that come back to the Camp have breakfast and then checkout from the Camp and then head towards Jodhpur. After reaching Jodhpur check in to the pre booked hotel and spend your leisure time according to you after that overnight stay.

Day 07: - Jodhpur Sightseeing to Udaipur (City Of Lakes)

Wake up in the morning have breakfast and then checkout from the hotel and head towards Udaipur. After reaching Udaipur check in to the pre booked hotel have some rest and then you Can explore local market. After that in Evening you can enjoy boating in Lake Pichola with light & Music Show. After that come back to the Hotel And overnight stay.

Day 08: - Udaipur full day sightseeing

Wake up in the morning have breakfast and then go for the sightseeing of Udaipur like: - City Palace, Jag mandir, Saheliyo ki Bari, Jagdish Temple, Vintage Car Museum, Bagore Ki haveli, Ambari Ghat, Under the Sun Fish Aquarium, etc. After that in Evening you can enjoy boating in Lake Pichola with light & Music Show. After that come back to the Hotel And overnight stay.



Day 09: - Remaining Sightseeing & Departure

Wake up in the morning have breakfast and then checkout from the hotel and then if you have time, you can enjoy remaining sightseeing of Udaipur or you can enjoy shopping if time permits. And after that our representative will drop you back to Jaisalmer Airport/Railway Station according to the timing of your Flight/Train.

Time	Location	Description
10:00-12:00	Amer Fort	• Hours: 9am-6pm • Cost: ₹ 25 for Indians, ₹ 200 for Foreign Tourists • What it is: A majestic fort with a hilltop setting and an opulent palace within its premises – that’s Amber Fort and Palace for you. It includes magnificent structures like the Sheesh Mahal, Shukh Niwas, and the Diwan-e-Khas or Hall of Private Audience.
13:00-14:30	Nahargarh Fort	• Hours: 9:30 am-5:30 pm • Cost: ₹ 10 for Indians, ₹ 50 for Foreign Tourists • What it is: a majestic monument that overlooks Jaipur and offers a stunning view of the city’s landscape. Built in 1734 by Jai Singh II, the then Maharaja of Jaipur, Nahargarh Fort was part of the city’s defense circle, along with Amer Fort and Jaigarh Fort.
14:30-15:00	Jal Mahal	• Hours: 9:00 am – 10:00 pm • Cost: Free for All • What it is: Standing in the middle of the Man Sagar Lake, Jal Mahal is a spectacular five-storied palace that features the Rajput style of architecture.When the lake is full, four of these stories remain submerged under the water and only the top one remains visible.
15:00-17:00	City Palace	• Hours: 09:30 am – 5:00 pm • Cost: ₹ 40 per Adult and ₹ 25 per Child for Indians • What it is: The architecture of this palace is a splendid blend of Rajput and Mughal styles.Adorned with sprawling gardens, courtyards, halls, royal residences, and art galleries, every part of this palace reflects Rajputana glory. The palace also houses a museum where you will come across the royal garments used by Maharaja Sawai Man Singh II and Maharaja Sawai Madho Singh I.
17:00-19:00	Hawa Mahal	• Hours: 09:00 am - 4:30 pm • Cost: ₹ 10 for Adults • What it is: <u>Hawa Mahal</u> is a five-storied pyramidal edifice constructed out of red and pink sandstone. It features 953 small windows and looks like a honey combed hive. The interior chambers of this building enjoy a cooling effect due to the breeze blowing in through its incredible lattice of windows

An Egyptian mummy housed here counts among its main attractions.
11:00-12:00	Birla Mandir	• Hours: 8am-12pm, 4pm-8pm • Cost: Free for All • What it is: The walls of the temple are ornamented with various scenes and quotes from the Bhagavad Gita. This grand place of worship looks spellbinding when illuminated at night.
12:00-16:00	Jaipur Main Market Visit	• Hours: 10:00 am – 11:00 pm; • Cost: Free for all • What it is: Market famous for Handicraft, Art & Craft, Rajasthani items. You Can explore: - Johri Bazar, Bapu Bazar, Choti Chopad, Badi Chopad.

09:30-11:00	City Palace	• Hours: 9:30am-5:30pm • Cost: ₹ 30 per Adult • What it is: The City Palace, located on the banks of Lake Pichola. The palace complex is divided into many beautiful villas and palaces, including Amar Vilas, Bhim Vilas, Krishna Vilas, Manak Mahal and Moti Mahal.
11:00-12:00	Jagmandir	• Hours: 10am-6pm • Cost: Free for all • What it is: It has divisions like the Garden Courtyard, Gul Mahal, Darikhana, Bara Patharon ka Mahal, Kunwar Pada ka Mahal and Zenana Mahal. This is another must-visit during your boat ride.
12:00-13:00	Jagdish Temple	• Hours: 5am-2:30pm, 4pm-10pm • Cost: Free for all • What it is: The <u>temples in Udaipur</u> lies near the City Palace’s Badi Pol entry and you have to go up through a few steps. The black stone deity of Lord Vishnu will awe you and so will the brass Garuda image facing it.
13:00-15:00	Saheliyo Ki Bari	• Hours: 9pm-7pm • Cost: ₹ 5 per Adult • What it is: This awe-inspiring development catered to the maids who would go with the Princess of Udaipur to her husband’s hearth (part of the dowry given by the Maharana). This place had pretty women dancing, singing and making merry and the beautiful marble elephants, fountains, a lotus pool and kiosks bear ample testimony to the richness of the time.
15:00-17:00	Fateh Sagar Lake	• Hours: 8am-6pm • Cost: Rs 30 per person for Regular Boat Ride Rs 100 – Rs 200 per person for Motor Boat Ride Rs 200 – Rs 400 per person for Speed Boat Ride • What it is: Exceptionally clean and expansive, the Fateh Sagar Lake is a great place to visit in Udaipur mainly for its 4 islands that are attractions in themselves. Accessible only by boat, the islands play host to public parks and a solar observatory that is worth a see.
17:00-19:00	Lake Pichhola	• Hours: 9am-7pm • Cost: ₹ 400 Per Person • What it is: Lake Pichola today is an iconic symbol of Udaipur. Measuring nearly 4 Km in length and 3 Km in width, the lake is a must-see place to visit in Udaipur. A myriad of palaces, temples, royal quarters and ghats and chabutaras have been developed around the lake and on its several islands over the years.
